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READING COMPREHENSION (2 points)

The School Council of the State agrees to ban mobile phones in primary schools and restrict them in high schools

Spain's School Council (Consejo Escolar del Estado) decided to limit mobile phone use in primary and secondary schools. The ban covers the entire compulsory education period, except for educational purposes in secondary schools. This is to address worries about potential problems with digital devices in schools. In primary and infant education, students are told not to bring mobile phones, tablets, or smartwatches. In secondary education, it's suggested to turn off mobile phones, and each school can decide their own rules.

This decision came after a meeting with Education Minister Pilar Alegría and President Pedro Sánchez. Also, President Sánchez's plan to help with math and reading will now include Baccalaureate (Bachillerato) and Basic Vocational Training (FP), benefiting over five million students. The government plans to spend 500 million euros on this plan, which includes smaller classes, better teacher training, and extra help after school.

Some people like these rules, but others, like the Federation of Associations of Mothers and Fathers (FAPA) Francisco Giner de los Ríos, say stopping mobile phones is avoiding the real problem. They say it's important to teach students how to use devices responsibly. Carmen Morillas, FAPA's president, talks about teaching responsible digital behavior. The decision makes people talk about finding the right rules for using digital devices in school.
